AGREED MOTION TO EXTEND DEFENDANTS' DEADLINE TO RESPOND TO PLAINTIFF'S MOTIONS FOR PARTIAL SUMMARY JUDGMENT

Defendants Natalie Pasdar, Individually and Natalie Pasdar, Emily Robison and Martha Maguire (incorrectly named in this lawsuit as Martha Seidel) d/b/a Dixie Chicks (collectively, "Defendants"), pursuant to Local Rule 6.2, submit their AGREED MOTION TO EXTEND DEFENDANTS' DEADLINE TO RESPOND TO PLAINTIFF'S MOTIONS FOR PARTIAL SUMMARY JUDGMENT and, for same, would respectfully show the Court as follows:

1. On or about June 25, 2009, Plaintiff Terry Hobbs ("Hobbs") filed his Plaintiff's Motion for Partial Summary Judgment an accompanying papers related to the issue of fair reporting ("Hobbs' First Motion").

2. On or about July 1, 2009, pursuant to an agreement between Defendants and Hobbs (Defendants and Hobbs collectively referred to as the "Parties"), the Court established July 31, 2009 as the Defendants' deadline to respond to Hobbs' First Motion.

3. On or about July 20, 2009, Hobbs filed a second Plaintiff's Motion for Partial Summary Judgment and accompanying papers related to the issue of Hobbs' status as a public figure ("Hobbs' Second Motion").

4. On or about July 21, 2009, during the deposition of Mr. Hobbs, counsel for all parties conferred to discuss the various deadlines to respond to Hobbs' First Motion and Hobbs' Second Motion, the need for discovery to properly respond to the motions, the Defendants' intention to file motions for summary judgment and the general desire to avoid unnecessary motion practice and agree upon a briefing schedule.

5. As a result of the Parties' discussions, as well as prior trial commitments, travel plans and vacation schedules, the Parties have agreed to extend the Defendants' deadline to respond to Hobbs' First Motion and Hobbs' Second Motion to September 15, 2009.

6. Accordingly, pursuant to Local Rule 6.2, the Parties respectfully request that this Court sign and enter the proposed Order and extend the date to respond to the Plaintiff's First and Second Motions until September 15, 2009. This extension will not prejudice the Parties, will not otherwise impact any dates set by the Court and will conserve both the Court's and the Parties' resources.
