FIELD INVESTIGATION, WEST MEMPHIS TRIPLE HOMICIDE, MAY 12 and MAY 13, 1993 - LUMINOL:

This analyst and Kermit Channell, Serologist responded to request to perform luminol on a potential crime scene area on May 12, 1993. We left that afternoon, arriving in West Memphis at approximately 6:30 P.M., proceeding to the Police Department.

Officers Tony Anderson, Brian Ridge, and Mike Allen accompanied Kermit and myself to a swampy area on the northern edge of West Memphis where the victims were found. A general survey of the area in the daylight hours was conducted. Approaching darkness fresh solutions of luminol reagent were prepared. When the area became dark, using flashlights for light support, the party returned to the area and proceeded to spray and locate areas of luminol light emission activity, a presumptive test for the presence of trace quantities of blood. The following observations were noted:

- (1) At a trail along a stream bed an approximately 11 foot high bluff overlooking the stream positive reactions were noted on either side of a tree with more reaction noted to the right side of the tree, facing the stream bed.
- (2) An area with used plastic sheeting west of the trail and the bluff gave more positive reactions were noted.
- (3) At the west bank of the stream bed, to the right of some trees, an area gave positive reaction. It was explained by the Police Department that this was where two of the victims were placed when they were recovered from the stream bed.
- (4) In the stream bed, below the described (at one time) water line, positive luminol tests indicated where one of the victims was found in the water as related by the Memphis Police Department.
- (5) On the east bank of the stream bed were a pile of sticks and a depression in the soil where luminol tests showed a concentrated area of positive reaction.

- (6) North of this point luminol tests gave positive reaction to a large area of concentration (described by the Memphis Police Department where the third victim was placed upon recovery from the water).
- (7) North of the point #6 near some tree roots, another large area of concentration of the luminol reaction was noted.
- (8) Trace amounts of positive luminol reaction was noted on the slope west of the area where two of the victims were recovered and placed. (reference area #3). The areas north and south of where the third victim had been placed (5) and (7) were unaccountable known activity by the Memphis Police Department or rescue/recovery operations.

From these areas of noted positive luminol reactions for the presumptive presence of trace amounts of blood the following opinion is rendered:

The traces of presumed blood detected along the trail (2), at the bluff (1), and on the slope (8) appear to be transfer of blood by the rescue and recovery teams.

Reaction in the areas where the recovered victims were placed is the apparent result of trace blood transfer from the victims (3) and (6).

The area below the water level on the west side of the stream was accounted as where trace amounts of the victim's blood diffused into the mud in the stream bed.

The areas (5) and (7) indicate activity prior to recovery of the victims and relate to activity to the victims when perhaps they were being attacked.

It should be noted that the luminol testing was performed some days after the discovery of the victims and at least one rainfall had occurred. There were no visible signs or indication of blood at any of the locations that we investigated.

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Upon the group returning that night to the police headquarters Inspector Gitche11 and his staff were advised of our findings. It is our opinion the crime had taken place where the bodies of the victims were recovered. Inspector Gitche11 was further advised of the inability to document the luminol reaction of this evening because of the light leaks from stars and the back scattered light from West Memphis. To document the luminescence Inspector Gitche11 was advised that we would have to place tenting over the areas of interest and to block out all stray light possible.

The luminescence requires near total darkness to document luminol reactions in the open field

It was decided that Kermit and I should stay over and the next day perform the tests again and photograph them.

The morning of May 13, Inspector Gitche11 provided us with equipment, supplies and manpower needed to document the areas of positive luminol reaction. A test with plastic covering over the canvas was erected and photographs were taken of the positive areas noted of the previous evening again with fresh luminol application.

Because of the limitations due to some light leakage, physical activity in the area destroying some of the reaction, the weather conditions of some light rain the night before and the originally low concentration levels in the areas on the bluff (area #1), along the trail (area #2), where the victims were placed (area #3), and the area in the stream bed where the body was recovered (area #4) and the area above the recovery area (area #8) we were not able to document photography as we observed these areas the evening of May 12.

The tented area over the areas where the victim's body was placed (#6) and the questioned area (#5), subdued the light to a degree that a less than perfect photograph could be obtained. These photographs still documented the areas of interest, showing luminol reaction in respective areas. These photographs were without the benefit of flash painting application to reference the areas photographed. A still photo of the questioned area from the original camera tripod location does reference the questioned area. The photographs were processed revealing the luminol reaction at areas where the victim was place (#6) and the questioned area (#5).

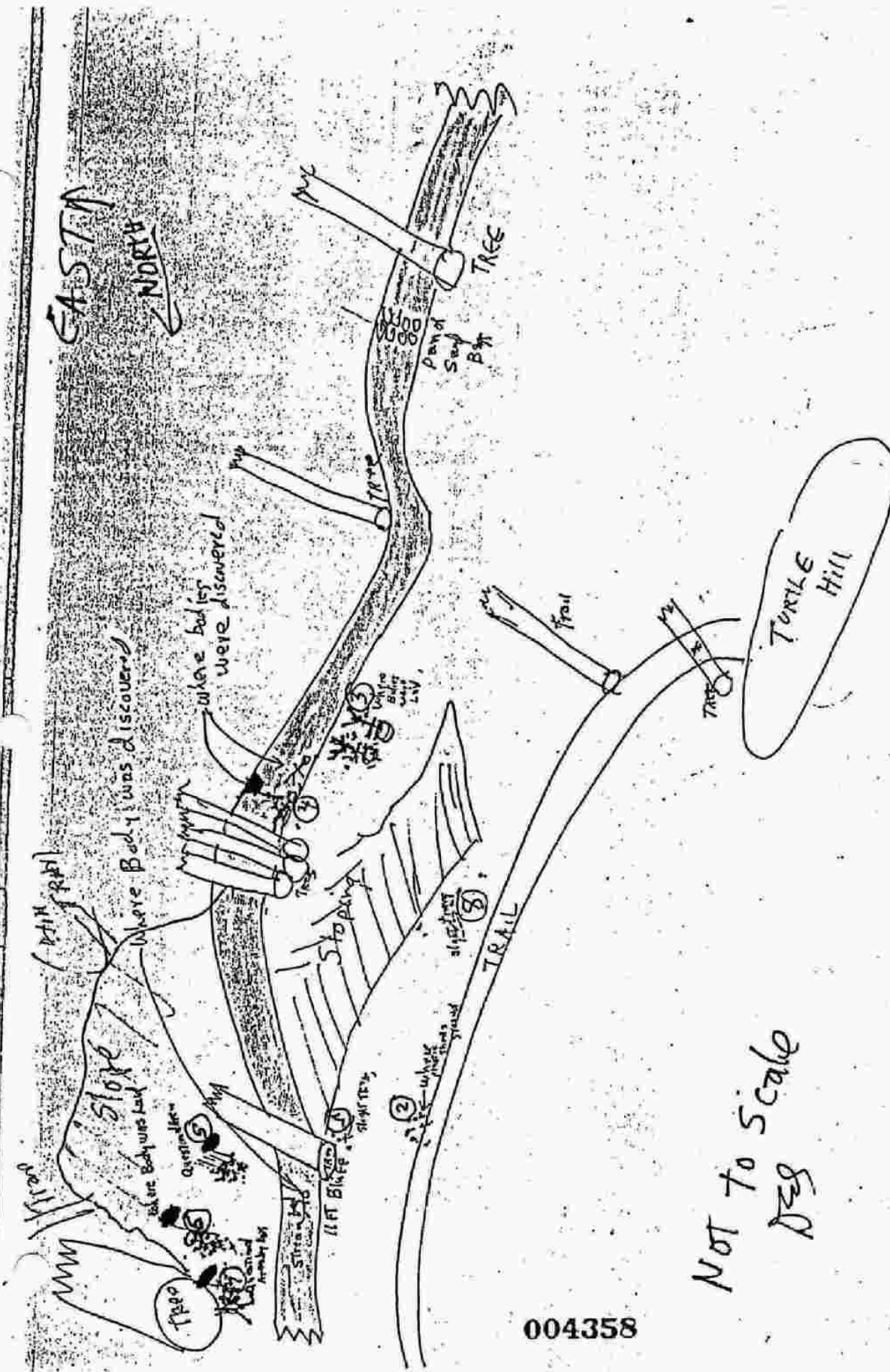

On 5-12-93, I went to the wooded area behind the Blue Beacon where the bodies were found in the above noted case. The time was about 8:30 to 8:45 PM and it was an overcast night. The purpose for being at the location was for the administering of a chemical known to me as Luminol. The procedure is to spray the area with this chemical and the presence of blood would cause a chemical reaction in which the area would illuminate where blood was found. Present at the time that I was at the crime scene were; Det. Sgt M. Allen, Det. T. Anderson, Det. Capt. T. Miller, Det. Lt. J. Sudberry, Crime Lab Specialist D. Smith, and Crime Lab Specialist K. Jannel.

In describing the area where blood was found I will use the landmarks previously noted in other reports and the locations that the victim's bodies were found since I was actually involved in the hands on removal of those bodies.

The first area of blood is an area north and east of Body #1. The area is a slow stopping area on the bank between a large tree that is a hollowed out area underneath. A root is exposed that it appears a rope could have been tied around. Just below the root in the soft bank two plaster cast foot prints were made and sent to the crime lab.

The second area of blood was found on the slowly sloping area just to the east of Body #1 on the bank. This is a portion of the bank that looks to have a slope of about 1 foot to a 3 ft distance. East of the blood about 5 feet begins a steep slope and west of the blood is the creek and body #1. Mr. Smith explained that a significant amount of blood was located here and it appeared that one or more of the victims apparently lost a lot of blood in that area.

The third area is east of Body #1 and just to the south. The area again is a slowly sloping area with a slope of about 1 foot in 2 1/2 foot. Just east of this area is another steep slope where foot prints were located that went up a point in the steep slope. This also was an area where it appeared to be a significant amount of blood where one or more of the victims may have bled a large amount.

The first three areas appeared to be about 4 1/2 to 5 feet above the bottom of the Ditch and at the time the bodies were located were exposed above the water line by over two feet.

The Fourth area is in the ditch just above to the north of Body #2. This area seemed to have a large amount of blood that appeared to be where the bodies bled out while in the water. This area would have been under the water when the bodies were discovered.

Area #5 is the area of sloping bank just west of bodies #2 and #3. This area is a sloping area of about 1 ft to a 1 3/4' slope with a steeper slope to the west and a clump of three trees to the north. South of the slope is a steep slope that goes into a gully type ditch that feeds the same creek. This gully was dry at the time the bodies were found and leads off in an westerly direction away from the creek.

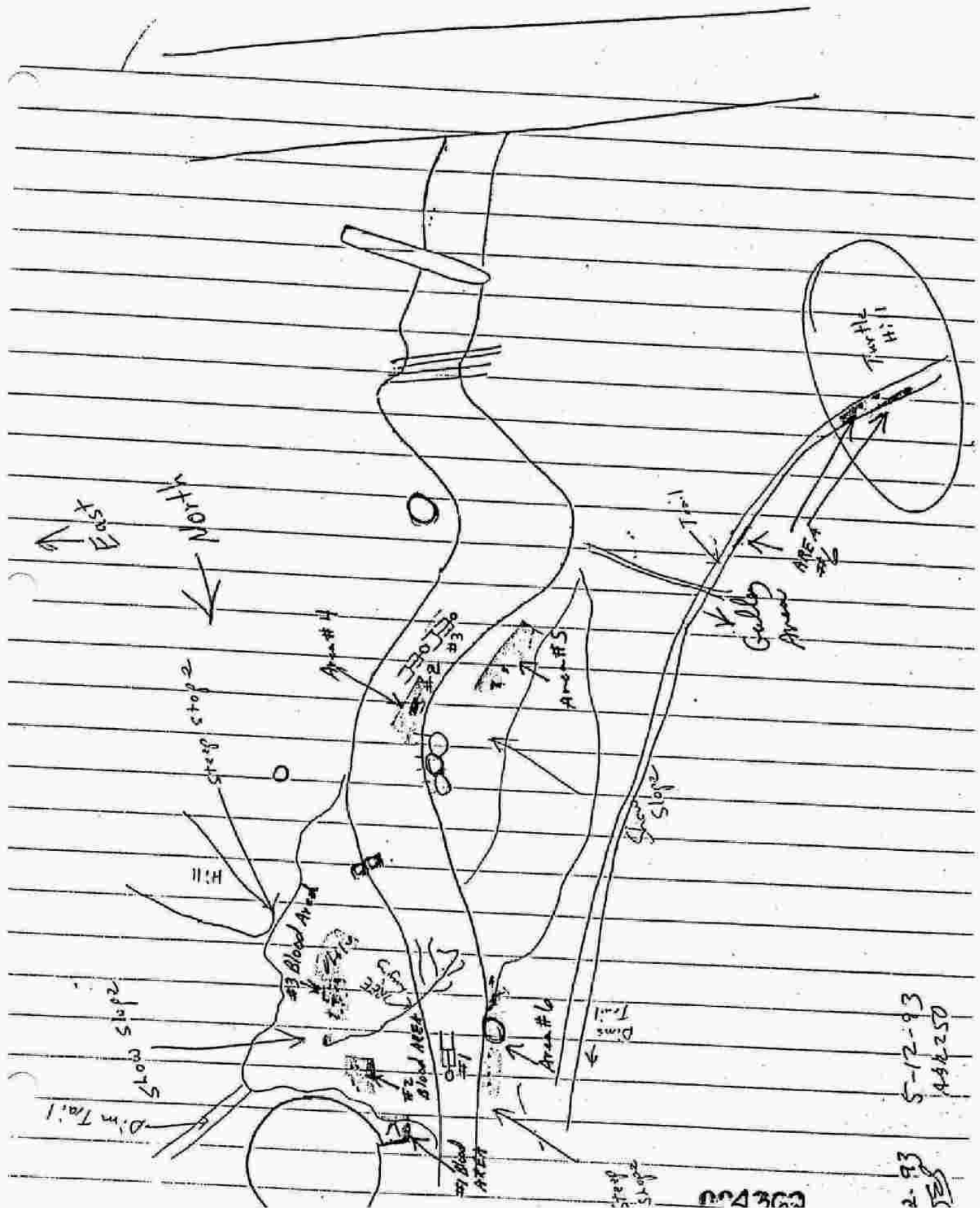
Area #6 is the steep bank to the west of Body #1. This area is an almost perpendicular bank that would be about 12-15 feet above and just west of Body #1. This blood may have been the result of the perpetrator standing in the area with an amount of blood on him or one of the bodies may have been placed there ~~prior~~ prior to being placed in the water.

Area #6 is a trail that runs in a South easterly direction from the crime scene. The area is a hill that climbs to the top of a tall peak just about 25 feet above the area. It appeared that blood was found along the trail. It appeared that the blood may have been the result of blood transfer from the crime scene either on the feet or clothing of someone leaving the area.

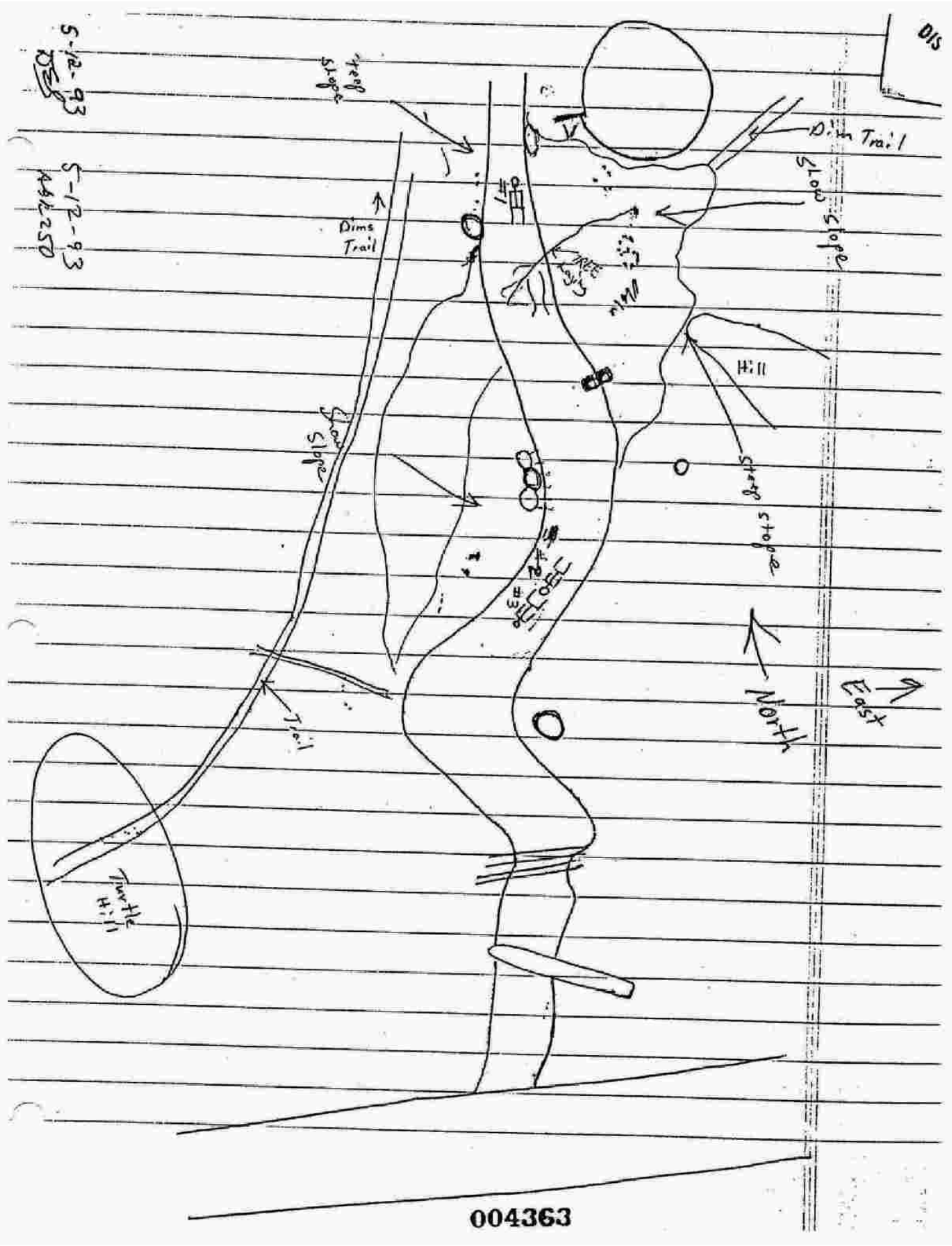

On May 12, 1993, State Crime Scene Technicians, Don Smith and Kermit Chanel with Sgt M. Allen and myself went to the area of the three victims of homicide were found. We arrived just before dark to spray a reagent called "Luminol" which causes and area that is suspect to have contained blood. A suspect blood area illuminate when the spray comes into contact what is believed to be blood. There were five areas that fluoresced when sprayed in the dark with the "Luminol". Two of these spots were where body number 1 and bodies 2 and 3 were laid out of the water by investigator.

On May 13, 1993 at 9:00 Am Technician Don Smith, Kermit Chanel, Det Shane Gierffor and myself went back to the scene where we met by Corporal Keith Hale and Harrison Robinson of the West Memphis funeral home. We proceeded to put up the tent/awning over two of the areas that had fluoresced last night. Putting up the awning we further darkened the area with black plastic so that the illumination of the reaction of the chemical could be photographed.

Photo #1 was shot at a point 7'0" from the mark on the large oak tree, where the paint spot had been sprayed as a reference point to measure from, this was in a straight line between the large oak and the three tree that had another paint spot on it for a second

Page 2 to the naked eye that appeared to be about three feet in diameter indicating a heavy blood area.

Photo # 2 is an area of illumination that is directly over the spot where Victim number 1 was lain upon the bank when he was pulled from the water. This spot is 3' 8" from the spot on the large oak tree in a direct line between that spot and the location the body was found in the water.

Photo #3 was taken on a root of the oak tree with the reference spot, the root is 6' 0" from the reference point in a straight line from that point heading straight into the water. The flowered area in front of the large root indicated an area that was downsloping toward the water, the illuminated spot formed a "V" like shape!

Areas that were to be photographed were at such an angle, the questionable area was probably washed due to the amount of rain and it was nearly a sheer drop off into the water. The spot illumination some on both sides of a tree that had been marked with a paint spot to be the third reference point. The cliff like area

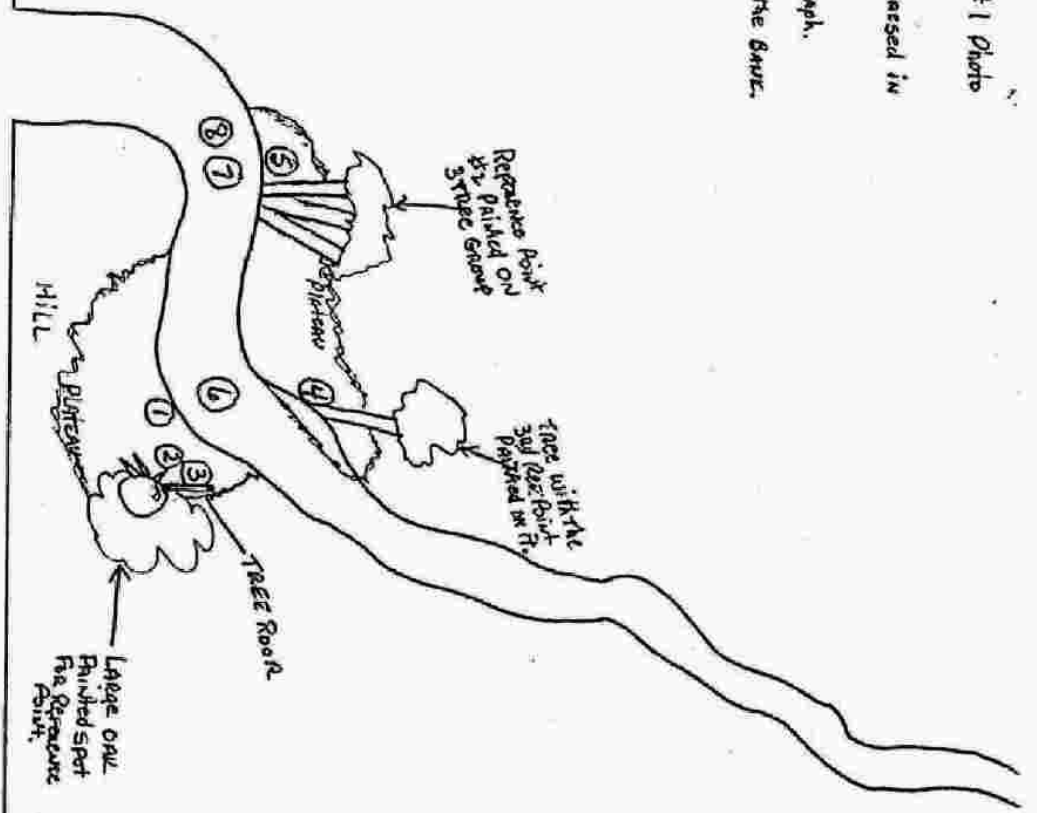



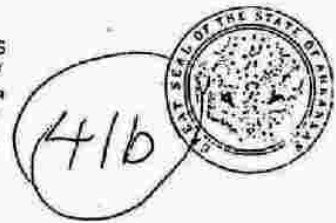

Some of the hairs in E70a and E35a were very similar to each other. The hairs in FP5 (Case 93-05717) were of this type and could have a common origin with either E70a or E35a.

A dark brown dyed hair of unknown origin was recovered from FP7 (Case 93-05717). A light brown Caucasian hair of unknown origin was recovered from E5. LS1 consisted of a brown Caucasian (possible) pubic hair of unknown origin. Numerous Caucasian hairs of unknown origin were recovered from BR1. A single Negroid hair fragment was recovered from FP10 (Case 93-05718). A brown Caucasian (possible) pubic hair fragment of unknown origin was recovered from E134. Should additional hair standards be submitted, these hairs will be re-examined.

It is possible that hairs not deemed of significant forensic value at the time of this report will become significant upon the submission of additional standards.

It is pointed out that hairs do not possess a sufficient number of unique individual microscopic characteristics to be positively identified as having originated from a particular person to the exclusions of all others.

The hairs and fibers will be retained in the Laboratory pending possible future comparisons.
