Petitioner Echols's Second Amended Petition for a Writ of Habeas Corpus, filed in this Court on or about October 29, 2007, challenged his 1994 state court murder convictions and related confinement in the Arkansas state prison under sentence of death. Further proceedings on that petition were stayed by order of this Court pending completion of petitioner's state court challenge to his conviction and sentence based on new scientific evidence, pursuant to Ark. Code § 16-112-201, et seq.

On August 19, 2011, the Craighead County Circuit Court vacated petitioner Echols's 1994 convictions and sentence, finding that, based on DNA test results and other compelling new evidence, a new trial would result in acquittal. As a result, the request for relief advanced in petitioner's October 29, 2007 petition has been rendered moot. Accordingly, petitioner respectfully requests that his October 29, 2007 petition challenging his 1994 murder convictions and sentence be dismissed.
