


Gentlemen:

Please let this letter serve as notice to defense counsel for all parties as to the aggravating circumstances the State intends to rely upon in the prosecution of the above referred to case. In the cases of State vs. Damien Echols and State vs. Jessie Misskelley the aggravating circumstances will be that each of these defendants had committed another felony, an element of which was the use or threat of violence to another person or the creation of a substantial risk of death or serious physical injury to another person and that the capital murder was committed in an especially cruel or depraved manner. In the case of State vs. Jason Baldwin the aggravating circumstance will be that the capital murder was committed in an especially cruel or depraved manner.
