ORDER FOR ATTENDANCE OF WITNESS  
FROM WITHOUT THE STATE IN CRIMINAL CASES

It appearing from the Petition of Brent Davis, the duly elected, qualified and acting Prosecuting Attorney within and for the Second Judicial Circuit of the State of Arkansas, of which Clay County is a part, that one William Cox, Jr., presently residing with Leon Brown at P. O. Box 1454 in Belton, Texas 76513, is a material and necessary witness for the State of Arkansas upon the trial of the above-named defendant, Jessie Lloyd Misskelley, Jr., in the Circuit Court of Clay County, Arkansas, for the felony crime of Capital Murder (three counts), and it appearing that it will not be an undue hardship on the witness to be required to attend and testify in said Circuit Court on the 27th and 28th days of January, 1994, nor will the witness be required to travel more than one thousand (1,000) miles to reach the place of trial by ordinary traveled routes, and it further appearing that the State of Arkansas and County of Clay will grant both civil and criminal immunity to the said witness while en route to the place of trial and while in Clay County, Arkansas, testifying at said trial, and that the State of Arkansas has tendered the sum of Three Hundred Twenty-two Dollars (\$322.00) for payment to the said William Cox, Jr. representing

mileage at the rate of twenty-three cents (23 cents) for each mile to be traveled (1400 miles round-trip), and the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) representing Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each day that he is required to travel and attend as a witness (two days of travel and two days of testimony).

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that Herman Cox, Jr., presently residing with Leon Brown at P. O. Box 1454 in Belton, Texas, does attend as a witness before this Court at the Clay County Court-house in Corning, Arkansas, on the 27th and 28th days of January, 1994, as commanded by the Subpoena or Summons attached hereto.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that there shall be paid to the said William Cox, Jr. the sum of Three Hundred Twenty-two Dollars (\$322.00) as compensation at twenty-three cents (23 cents) per mile for each mile to be traveled by ordinary traveled route to and from the Court where the prosecution is pending (1400 miles round trip), and that he be further paid the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) representing Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) as compensation for each day necessarily traveled in going to and returning from the place of trial and as payment for each day required to attend as a witness (four days), for a total of Four Hundred Twenty-two Dollars (\$422.00).

IT IS SO ORDERED this 13 day of January, 1994.
