PETITION FOR ATTENDANCE OF WITNESS
FROM WITHOUT THE STATE IN CRIMINAL CASES

I, Brent Davis, Prosecuting Attorney within and for the Second Judicial Circuit of the State of Arkansas, of which Clay County is a part, in the name and by the authority of the State of Arkansas, petition the Court as follows:

(1) That the above defendant, Jessie Lloyd Misskelley, Jr., presently stands charged in the Circuit Court of Clay County, Arkansas, with three counts of the felony crime of Capital Murder.

(2) That William Cox, Jr., presently residing with Leon Brown at P. O. Box 1454 in Belton, Texas 76513, is a material and necessary witness in such prosecution and his presence will be required and will be necessary for a period of two (2) days on the 27th and 28th days of January, 1994; that it will not be an undue hardship on the witness to be required to attend and testify in the Clay County Circuit Court on said days, nor will the witness be required to travel more than one thousand (1,000) miles by ordinary travel routes to reach the place of trial; that the State of Arkansas and County of Clay will grant both civil and criminal immunity to the said witness while en route to the place of trial and while in Clay County, Arkansas, testifying at

said trial; that the State of Arkansas and County of Clay do hereby tender the sum of Three Hundred Twenty-two Dollars (\$322.00) for payment to the said William Cox, Jr. representing mileage at the rate of twenty-three cents (23 cents) for each mile to be traveled by the ordinary travel route to and from the Court where the prosecution is pending (1400 miles round trip), and further tender the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) representing Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) per day for each day that he is required to travel and attend as a witness (two days of travel and two days of testimony).

WHEREFORE, petitioner prays that a Certificate and Summons be issued by David Burnett, a Judge of the Circuit Court of Crittenden County, Arkansas, directing that William Cox, Jr., presently residing with Leon Brown at P. O. Box 1454 in Belton, Texas 76513, attend and testify in behalf of the State of Arkansas in the above-styled criminal prosecution on the 27th and 28th days of January, 1994
