ORDER

NOW on this 4th day of August, 1993, comes on for hearing the Motion for Discovery of Brent Davis, Prosecuting Attorney within and for the Second Judicial District of the State of Arkansas, by and through John N. Fogleman, Deputy Prosecuting Attorney for Crittenden County, Arkansas, requesting that the defendant, Jesse Lloyd Misskelley, Jr., be required to give samples of his blood, saliva, head hair, body hair, pubic hair, fingerprints and footprints, for medical examination and comparison, and after considering the Motion for Discovery and statements of counsel, the Court finds:

- (1) The defendant, Jesse Lloyd Misskelley, Jr., has been arrested and charged with three counts of Capital Murder.
- (2) The State of Arkansas, by its Motion for Discovery, has requested that the defendant be required to furnish samples of his blood and saliva in sufficient quantities for testing, and samples of his head hair, body hair and pubic hair, and also his fingerprints and footprints.
- (3) The request of the State for discovery involves no unreasonable intrusion of the defendant's body.

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COURT CONSIDERED AND ORDERED that the defendant be required to permit the taking of sufficient samples of his blood, saliva, head hair, body hair and pubic hair for testing and analysis and for examination and comparison by the Arkansas State Crime Laboratory, and also to permit the taking of his fingerprints and footprints.
