MOTION FOR ASSISTANCE OF EXPERTS

Jessie Lloyd Misskelley, Jr., Defendant, for his  
Motion for Assistance of an Expert states:

1. That the Defendant is charged with the offenses of three (3) counts of Capital Murder.
2. That the State intends to try the Defendant possibly in December, 1993 or in January, 1994.
3. That the Defendant is indigent.
4. That in order to properly prepare for his defense at such trial, the Defendant requires an independent chemical analysis of the material seized at the time of his arrest and which shall be offered by the State as evidence against the defendant at the time of trial.
5. That the independent chemical analysis is needed to insure the defendant's right to a fair trial and to due process of law as guaranteed by the Arkansas and U.S. Constitutions.
6. That the services of such experts are estimated to cost \$4,000.00 to \$5,000.00, which sum the


