ORDER

On this 16th day of November, 1993, there comes on to be heard the Motion to Transfer to Juvenile Court of the Defendant, and this matter is submitted to the Court upon said Motion, the testimony of witnesses, and statements of counsel, from which the Court doth find:


1. That the Defendant's Motion to Transfer to Juvenile Court is hereby denied by the Court, the Court having found by clear and convincing evidence that the defendant should be tried as an adult.

2. In determining that the defendant should be tried as an adult, the Court makes these specific findings:


- a. that the crime with which the defendant is charged is a most serious crime;
- b. that the Defendant has a prior history of Juvenile offenses;
- c. that the defendant is likely to engage in aggressive behavior again;


- d. that there is little or no prospect for rehabilitation for the defendant.
3. The fact that the defendant was seventeen years of age at the time of the alleged offense also weighs heavily on the Court's decision to try him as an adult.
