ORDER REGARDING COURT PROCEEDINGS

After careful consideration of the rights of the Defendants and the State to fair and impartial proceedings attendant to these cases; and considering the public's right/want to know as much about the proceedings as possible, the court concludes that, while courtroom observers, members of the press/media or other similar persons have a right, subject to space and behavior requirements, to be fully present at such proceedings, there should be no recording by recording or video device nor photographing within the courtroom/hearing/trial place; and for security and

other purposes, given the multi-use of the facilities, no photographing should be permitted within the courthouse facility.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that any and all persons, except official court personnel in their official capacities, be and they are, prohibited from utilizing any camera, video or audio recorder, or similar device within the hearing/trial room/s, and from photographing, videoing, or using similar equipment within the courthouse facility where such proceedings are being held. If photographs/videos/etc. are desired, same shall be utilized only as the parties or attorneys are approaching or leaving the building, and then in such a way as not to interfere with security in accordance with the officers' requirements in connection with the safe transport and court appearances of the Defendants.
